Nomination Criteria

Athlete

- Graduate of Christian/Columbia College
- Attended the college for a minimum of two years
- Graduated prior to October 15, 2005
- Demonstrated outstanding athletic achievement and had significant impact on his/her respective sport (i.e., earned All-American honors, led nation in a significant statistical category, distinguished himself/herself and the college through major victories, records or other substantial accomplishments)
- Conducted himself/herself in such a manner to reflect honor on the college by displaying sportsmanship and outstanding character

Coach

- Coached a minimum of five seasons at Christian/Columbia College
- Departed the college prior to October 15, 2005
- Made a significant contribution to the personal success of his/her players and attained significant accomplishments (i.e., earned coach of the year honors, led team to national tournament, recorded an outstanding career record)
- Conducted himself/herself in such a manner to reflect honor on the college by displaying sportsmanship and outstanding character

Outstanding Contributors

- Individual or group that made a significant contribution to the growth of the Athletic Department and exhibited dedication and loyalty to intercollegiate athletics and/or a particular sport (i.e., volunteer, national championship team, faculty/staff member, supporter)
