The Cougar Basketball Academy is in its 22nd season as one of the finest youth camps in Missouri.

The Academy is designed to develop the basketball potential of each participant. Columbia College Coach Bob Burchard and his staff stress fundamentals and team concepts integral to successfully playing basketball.



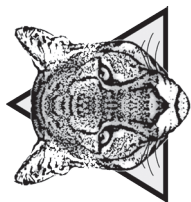
The Academy staff takes pride in the amount of individual instruction each participant receives. Staff members include current and former Columbia College basketball players and top area coaches. Additionally, several contests of skill and shooting are held at various times during each camp session.

Coach Bob Burchard is the most successful coach in Cougar basketball history. Through his first 22 seasons, Burchard amassed a record of 544-212. He has guided the basketball Cougars to 14 NAIA Men's National Basketball Championship tournament appearances. In 2009, after winning the AMC Tournament championship, Columbia advanced deeper into the NAIA National Tournament than they ever had before, making it all the way to the championship game. The Cougars ended their season with a 30-8 record, marking the fourth 30-win season under Burchard's direction.

For a four-year span, from 2005-2008, Burchard served as the NAIA representative on the USA Basketball Collegiate Committee. The Committee is responsible for recommendations concerning USA Basketball's men's collegiate events, including the selection of players and coaches. Other coaches on the committee include Jim Boeheim (Syracuse), Tom Izzo (Michigan State), Bill Self (Kansas) and Tubby Smith (Minnesota).

In the summer of 2008 Burchard was inducted into the Missouri Basketball Coaches Association (MBCA) Hall of Fame.

Burchard received his bachelor's degree in education from Catawba College in 1979 and his master's degree from East Carolina University in 1980. He is a native of McLean, Virginia. Burchard's wife, Faye, is Dean of Campus Life at Columbia College. The Burchards have two grown children, Jennifer and Bret.

The Academy offers the finest individualized instruction available to students entering kindergarten through the eighth grade.

Site and Facilities

The renovated and air-conditioned Southwell Complex, nicknamed the Cougar Dome, and the student recreation center house all camp activities. The spacious facility offers room for numerous camp stations and courts.

All campers will arrive at and depart from the Complex through the main entrance off Pannell Street. Allow for timely arrival and departure.

What to Bring

Each camper should come appropriately dressed to play basketball. Shorts, t-shirt, white socks and basketball shoes are standard. All campers will receive a camp t-shirt.

Cost and Registration

Enrollment for the Cougar Basketball Academy is extremely affordable! Cost for the camp for grades K-3 is \$50. Cost for campers in grades four through eight is \$85.

A \$10 fee reduction is available for families with more than one child enrolled in the camp. This reduction is available for members of the immediate family — i.e., brothers and sisters — only.

After enrollment, a \$10 administrative fee will be charged for cancellations and refund requests.
